

# CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

## 3 Years Old & Kindergarten Four Year Olds

First Baptist Academy is proud to offer its 3/K4 students a balance of age-appropriate opportunities to develop a love of learning and a strong spiritual foundation.

Our curriculum is a balance of developmental activities and academics. This program provides a small teacher/student ratio in a structured environment. It is NOT a day care program. The Academy desires to prepare four year old children spiritually, academically, physically, and emotionally for our elementary program.

- Students must be three or four years old by September 1 and potty trained. Parents must present a valid birth certificate for verification.
- All students are required by the Texas Department of Protective and Regulatory Services to be immunized according to the Texas State Vaccine Requirements. Proof of these immunizations must be given to the Academy prior to the first day of classes.
- Parents must attend an orientation prior to the first day of school.
- Every new student will be given a three-week period of adjustment after which his/her behavior will be evaluated. If a student is discovered to have any serious discipline problems, he/she will be dismissed from the Academy without financial reimbursement.

The Academy does not offer programs during the school day for students with special needs, academically or emotionally, which would require individual supervision and the teacher to depart from the regular curriculum and/or structured programs.

The Academy is exempt from the requirements imposed by the Americans with Disability Act. Due to the size and limitations of our school facilities and equipment, the Academy is unable to provide a modified classroom setting for students with special needs. Ex: deaf students, students in wheelchairs, students with immune deficient diseases. These children are precious in God's sight and need a school wherein they will receive all that they need.

If the student is taking any medication on a continual basis for any medical reason, please explain to the school nurse prior to enrollment.
