Summer Reading BINGO is to be played all summer to encourage reading in a fun way for FBA students entering 1st through 3rd grades!

To play, students complete a summer reading activity and then color in the square when it's finished (An adult needs to initial in the corner box of each space as the activity is completed). To get a BINGO, five in a row (vertical, horizontal, or diagonal) must be completed. Have students try for a Blackout BINGO and complete all the activities! The BINGO board can even be laminated or put in a clear page protector for longer durability!
